Statistics in TMClass



- ❑ Started with >110,000 English terms
- ❑ Other languages ranging from 8,000 to 60,000 (DE)
- ❑ Cleaning up resources – Reduce EN to 93,000
- ❑ Language Equality
 - ❑ 93,000 terms in all EU languages too €€€ without automation
 - ❑ Mining data for translations
 - ❑ DB grew from 400,000 to 2.1m terms
- ❑ Conceptual clustering
 - ❑ Non essential entries removed – DB shrunk to 1.5m terms
 - ❑ Semi-automatic creation of 50,000 meaning clusters
- ❑ Taxonomy built for the top layers and concepts linked



Importance of IP to EU Economy

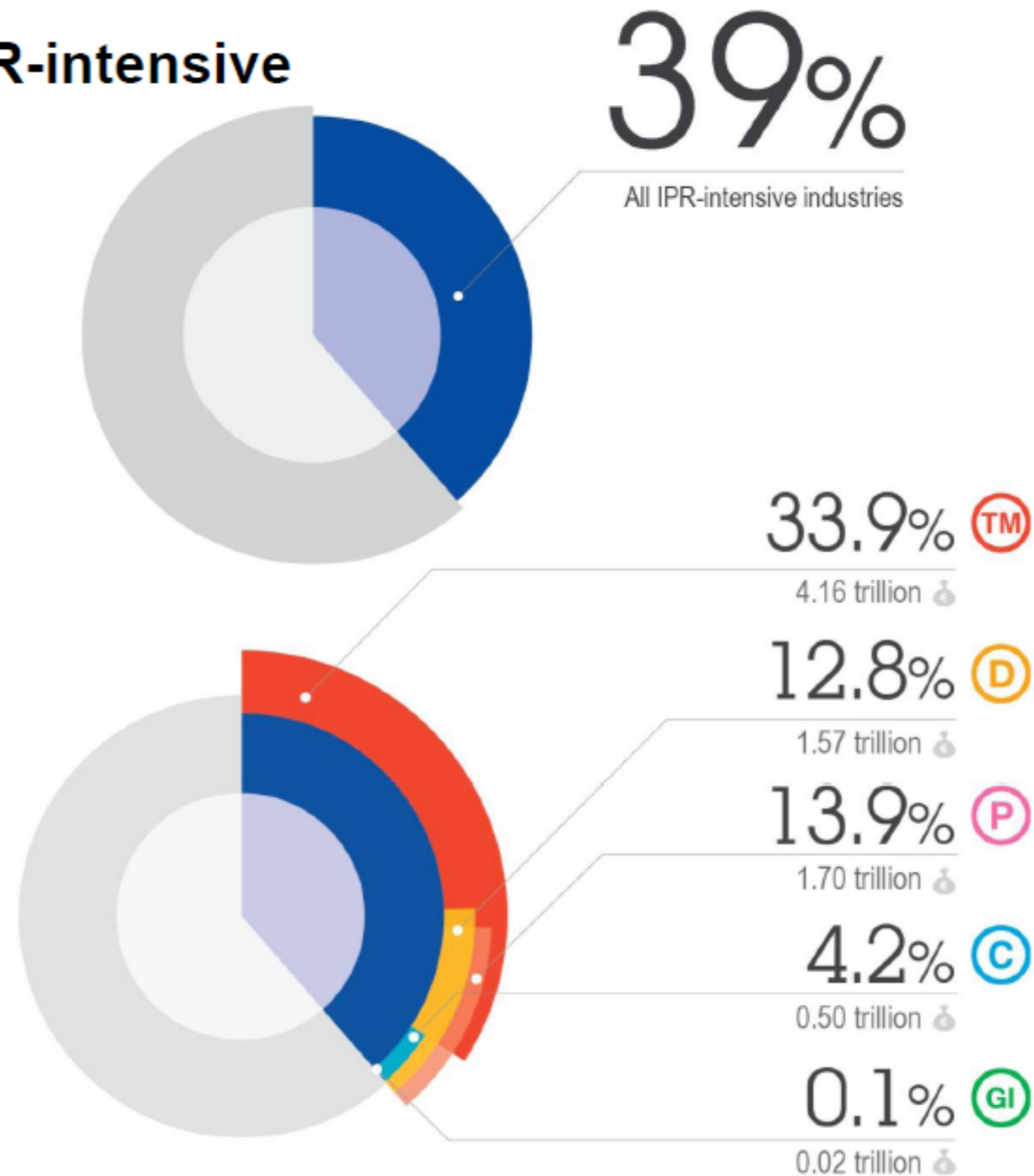


Contribution of IPR-intensive industries to GDP

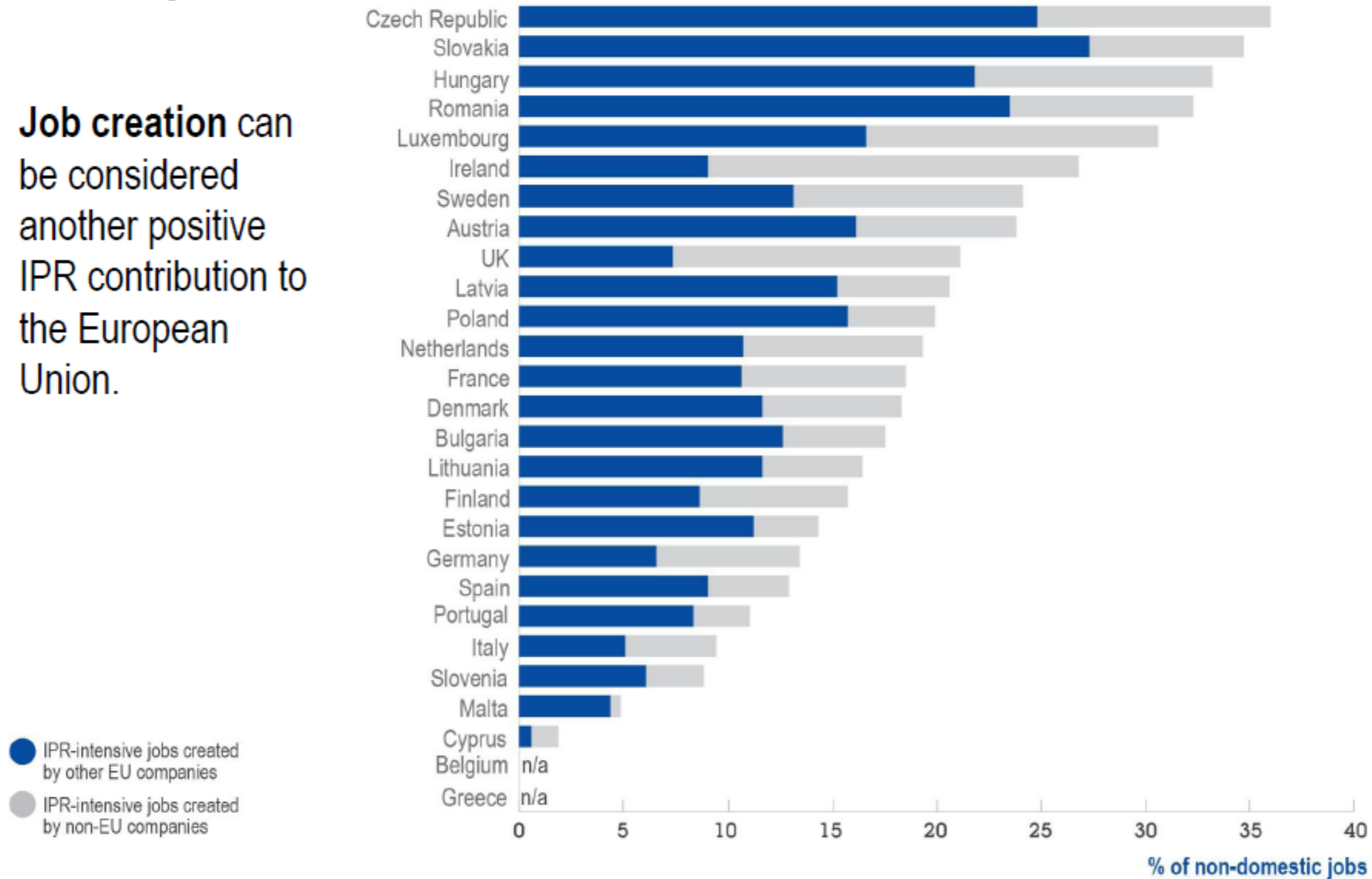
Key Role of Cross-Border
