# How to solve discoverability issues of OER to foster adoption?

- There are some efforts from OER search engines available (with federated search), but most of this retrieval mechanisms and OER providers remains disconnected from each other with some challenges, like non homologated metadata that produces noneffective searches.
- Adoption of best practices and learn from successful initiatives like
  - Open Access (OA):
    - Implementation of Guidelines like OpenAIRE to foster interoperability and visibility (<https://guidelines.openaire.eu>)
    - Introduction of dynamic metadata (i.e. tagging) based on crowdsourcing in OER web initiatives
    - Support of OER catalogs that harvest OER thematic repositories and OER websites (i.e. [oercommons.org](http://oercommons.org) and [temoa.info](http://temoa.info)).
